PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The CES will integrate the MJC and more specifically the families pole and environmental issues.

* Shared gardens:

- Support for gardeners in the implementation of gardening techniques respectful of the environment (workshops, conferences ...)
- Participation in the establishment and animation of a collective and educational plot in connection with the gardeners and towards a varied public (young people, children, migrants, isolated people, the elderly ...)
- Participation in the construction and animation of highlights such as the Green Week and the Nature Festival

* Alternatives to consumption:

- Participation in the monthly Gratiferia: Free barter space where everyone can donate items they do not need anymore or take without obligation of reciprocity
- Participation in the Christmas Rebellion: week of animation proposing alternatives to consumption under the sign of ZeroWaste

* Implication in a project lead by the House of Europe with the MJC : "Europe over the Rhone" and aims to show the inhabitants how Europe is acting on the territories around the Rhône around questions like tourism, renewable energies, biodiversity ...

* The CES will stay 11 month.

ACCOMMODATION, FOOD AND TRANSPORT ARRANGEMENTS

The MJC will be in charge of the reception of CES (accommodation in single room, activities, tutoring, food ..).

- Hosting in shared flat with another CES in Valence. MJC in charge about it and cost too
- Food : MJC will give you money (200E/month).
- Transport : mensual card

TRAINING DURING THE PROJECT

- From sending organisation : Departure preparation, points during the mission (by mail, Skype,...), middle évaluation, final evaluation and Youthpass, and seminar
- From MJC (hosting organisation) : hosting meeting, project meeting, point during mission (face to face), OLS, individual project
- From French agency : seminar arriving and middle time
- From Romans International (coordination) : arrival point, point during the mission and before to come back.
